BYOD Device Requirements & Student Responsibilities

Essential

The department's Wi-Fi network installed in high schools operates on the **802.11n 5Ghz standard**. Devices that do not support this standard *will not be able to connect*. NOTE: Student devices are only permitted to connect to the department's Wi-Fi network while at school. There is no cost for this service.

Operating system, software and anti-virus:

Students must ensure they have a current or prior, legal and licensed version of a supported operating system **(NOT ANDRIOD)** and of software. If applicable, students' devices must be equipped with anti-virus software.

Battery life and charging:

The device should have a minimum of 5hrs battery life to last the school day. Students must ensure they bring their device to school fully charged for the entire school day. *No charging equipment will be supplied by the school.*

Maintenance and support:

Students are solely responsible for the maintenance and upkeep of their devices.

Other Considerations

Sufficient capacity of process and store data effectively. Students are responsible for backing-up their own data and should ensure this is done regularly.

Back-up storage: Consider a portable hard drive as an appropriate source of back-up storage for essential documents

Tough and sturdy casing to avoid breakage, lightweight for ease of carrying, durable and strong, with a carry case or skin to protect the device.

Students should ensure they are comfortable using their device continuously during a school day, particularly in relation to screen size (recommended approx10'), sturdy keyboard etc.

Camera / microphone / head set - dependent on courses studied.

Theft / damage / insurance / warranty:

Students are responsible for securing and protecting their devices at school. Any loss or damage to a device is not the responsibility of the school or the Department. *The school will not accept responsibility for loss or breakage.* Students and their parents/caregivers are responsible for arranging their own insurance and should be aware of the warranty conditions and the terms of insurance policies for the device.

Confiscation:

Students' devices may be confiscated if the school has reasonable grounds to suspect that a device contains data which breaches the BYOD student Agreement or the schools devices policy.

BRING YOUR OWN DEVICE (BYOD) STUDENT AGREEMENT

Students must read and sign the BYOD Student Agreement in the company of a parent or caregiver unless otherwise directed by the principal.

I agree that I will abide by the school's BYOD policy and that:

- I will only connect to the internet, when at school, through the Department's Wi-Fi filtered network and use it only to assist my learning.
- I will use my device during school activities at the direction of the teacher.
- I will not attach any school-owned equipment to my mobile device without the permission of the school
- I will use my own portal/internet log-in details and will never share them with others
- I will stay safe by not giving my personal information to strangers
- I will not hack or bypass any hardware and software security implemented by the department or my school.
- I will not use my own device to knowingly search for, link to, access or send anything that is
 - > Offensive
 - > Pornographic
 - > Threatening
 - > Abusive or
 - Defamatory
 - Considered to by bullying
- I will report inappropriate behaviour and inappropriate material to my teacher
- I understand that my activity on the internet is recorded and that these records may be used in investigations, court proceedings or for other legal reasons.
- I acknowledge that the school cannot be held responsible for any damage to, or theft of my device.
- I understand and have read the limitations of the manufacturer's warranty on my device, both in duration and in coverage.
- I have read the BYOD Student Responsibilities document and agree to comply with the requirements
- I have reviewed the BYOD Device Requirements document and have ensured my device meets the minimum outlined specifications.
- I have read and will abide by the NSW Department of Education's Online Communication Services Acceptable Usage for School Students.
